Impact Experiences are a powerful, experiential opportunity for people to learn about and engage in poverty awareness. This experience is designed to increase social awareness of the challenges living in poverty can present by giving participants a glimpse of the barriers faced by a low-income family surviving month to month.

Real Life. Real Choices. (60 – 90 minutes)

Participants engage in a variety of scenarios based on real families from Central Indiana and break into low-income family units, to create a month's budget. Each month, they will attempt to financially navigate through an unforeseen circumstance while learning about the services and opportunities these families utilize to attempt to meet their basic needs. After the simulation, participants can join in discussion and learn about the real-life statistics of families and individuals in our Central Indiana communities.
